MEET LESA WILLIAMS

It is appropriate that Lesa Williams, our volunteer of the month, was born in the state of Missouri and, except for the last two years, lived her entire life in Missouri (the "SHOW ME STATE"). This is because Lesa shows us how to overcome challenges and how to be happy, contented and likable—just like the person we know today.

Lesa moved to Marion approximately two years ago and soon joined the Senior Center where she now volunteers as a "Greeter" every Monday. After her birth and early education in Unionville, Missouri she attended nearby Indian Hills College in Centerville, Iowa to obtain a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) degree. She then began a 27 year career as an LPN with the Northern Regional Medical Center in Kirksville, Missouri.

Lesa has had to face some challenges. Life has not been a bed of roses for Lesa. Her 35 year marriage to Leroy Williams ended with his death approximately 12 years ago. She has also had to endure the death of her oldest sister, Cathy. Her challenges continued with health problems: bouts with thyroid cancer in 1991 and breast cancer in 2013 and a stroke in 2012 which necessitated a pacemaker implant in 2014. These diffi-



culties would have crushed a lesser person but membership in the Grace Baptist Church certainly helped her.

Undaunted, Lesa soldiers on. She goes to the YMCA three times per week for water aerobics and has become adept at crocheting and at making cards for almost all occasions. She also has three children; twin girls, Gina and Tina, age 38 and a son, Travis, age 37.

She loves to travel on the trips offered by the Senior Center. She especially enjoyed the trip to Wheeling, West Virginia to observe their Christmas lights. Mostly recently, her independent travel is confined to trips back to Missouri.

Lesa's life is an example to follow and a definite asset to the Senior Center.
