Volunteer of the Month

MEET MARTHA COCHERL

Our volunteer of the month, Martha "Cookie" Cocherl entered this world in 1943 into a family of ten children in Ironspot, Ohio, a tiny unincorporated community of Muskingum county east of Columbus. As a young baby Cookie's father was not fond of his new daughters' name, Martha, and instead he started to call her by a nickname "Cookie". She liked this name and so it has accompanied her through life, although she still likes the name Martha.

Cookie attended Roseville High School in Roseville just a few miles from Ironspot. Soon after high school graduation she married Donald and they moved to Marion for his employment. In 1970 she began an 18 year career at GTE as a telephone operator. Along the way Cookie had a son, Jon and a daughter, Donna, both of whom are living in the Marion area. She has also endured the death of her husband, Donald, in 2013 and five of her siblings which originally included four brothers and five sisters. However, she has been truly blessed with 12 great grandchildren.

After being a ten year member of the Senior Center you can probably find Cookie every Tuesday morning at the Center as she volunteers as a "Greeter".



She is also a member of the Center's choir "Seniors in Song" — the second choir to which she belongs — the first being her local church choir, Fairpark Baptist Church. Although these activities at the Center keep Cookie active, she enjoys bowling once every week at Southland Lanes.

Cookie loves to travel and has taken many of our Senior Center trips. She especially enjoyed the trip to Nashville to see the Christmas lights and the trip to Amish country.
