## Volunteer of the Month

#### **MEET LARRY RODMAN** By Tim Frericks

Our volunteer of the month, Larry Rodman may not be well known nor his name found in the history books. In spite of this, he is the world to his wife Susan and his three children, Larry Jr., Kirk and Wendy. Larry's life has not known spectacular events and high profile awards but daily, steady, abiding selflessness has been his hallmark.

Larry was born on September 25, 1946 in Galion, Ohio. His family soon moved to Marion and Larry attended schools in Marion and Harding High School. Larry furthered his education at Marion Tech in its business program which enabled him to become a "line foreman" at Tecumseh Products in Marion. After many years at Tecumseh he was able to secure employment at Stabil Drill in Lafayette, Louisiana until his retirement in 2012. Then in retirement Larry and Susan returned to Marion.

Larry and Susan both grew up in the same west side Marion neighborhood and became fast friends. Today they have been married 52 years. Unfortunately Susan has been wheelchair bound but with Larry's help is able to conduct Craft Class at the Senior Center. Larry's volunteering not only enables Susan to tend and instruct the Craft Class but he



assists her in creating the crafts. His specialty is woodworking.

When not at their Craft Class Larry and Susan are often on the road visiting their children who are now located in three different states. Larry will load Susan's wheelchair in their Chevy Traverse SUV and off they go to visit Larry Jr. near Williamsport; Kirk in Breaux Bridge, Louisiana and Wendy in North Augusta, South Carolina.
