ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH TIGER CORPORATOIN FOR THE PURCHASE OF A TRACTOR AND BOOM MOWER FOR THE CITY OF MARION, OHIO, APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has the understanding that the Public Works Departments are expressing the need to purchase a Tractor and Boom Mower; and

WHEREAS, Under ORC 9.48 (Joint Purchasing Programs), a political subdivision can participate in a joint purchasing program operated by or through a national or state association of political subdivision in which the purchasing political subdivision is eligible for membership; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Public Works Director is hereby authorized and is hereby directed to enter into contract with Tiger Corporation (ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Contract #207-20) for the purchase of a new Tractor and Boom Mower for use at the Landfill, Streets Department, and Stormwater Department. The cost is \$192,521.00 and will be funded from the sanitation, SMMR, and Stormwater Funds.

Section 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; and we currently do not have an operable mower to meet our obligations of landfill maintenance; and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
