

ORDINANCE MAKING AN APPROPRIATION IN THE BELOW LISTED
LINE ITEM FOR THE SENIOR CENTER TO PURCHASE VEHICLES
FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THROUGH
THE US DOT FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Marion City Council passed Resolution 2020-20 dated May 26, 2020 to authorize the Senior Center to apply for a grant from the Ohio Department of Transportation to purchase vehicles through a Federal Grant,

WHEREAS, The Marion Senior Center has been notified by the Ohio Department of Transportation that the purchase of one vehicle is available currently at a cost to the city of \$9,808.00 with the Federal Grant paying the remaining cost of \$39,232.00.

WHEREAS, The Senior Center needs funds appropriated in the Capital Equipment line item to cover the local share for the cost of this vehicle and another vehicle later this year.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County Ohio:

Section 1. The Council finds it necessary to authorize the Service Director to execute all contracts and agreements necessary to complete the purchase of transportation vans for the Senior Center under the previous authorized and now awarded Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) 5310 Grant funding. The previous Grant authorizations being found in Res. No. 2020-20 passed on 5/26/2020.

Section 2. The Auditor is hereby authorized to make the following appropriation from the existing Senior Transportation MCCA Levy Fund:

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof: and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council: otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
