ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE ONE GARBAGE PACKER THROUGH RUSH TRUCK CENTERS THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO (ODOT) AND SOURCEWELL GOVERNMENT CONTRACT PRICING FOR THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The Sanitation Department is in need to replace a 16year old garbage packer and to replace with a new 2021 Garbage packer

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Public Works Director shall be authorized to purchase the new Truck Chasse from International Truck at a price of \$109,719.14 (ODOT), and to purchase the Packer body from Bell Equipment (Sourcewell) at a price of \$84,680 for a total amount of \$194,399.14 payable from the Capital Equipment Fund (503.5005.5304).

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, welfare and safety of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof, given the immediate need of the recycling truck, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
