

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO DISPOSE OF VEHICLES PREVIOUSLY UTILIZED BY VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS, AND DECLARING THEY ARE NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR ANY PUBLIC PURPOSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Council has been advised that vehicles previously used by the below departments listed are no longer necessary, and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has been advised by the Director of Public Service that the vehicles mentioned are no longer necessary for any municipal purpose.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio;

**Section 1.** That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of the following vehicles previously used by the Fire, Streets, Transit, Airport, Parks, Police, Sanitation and Senior Center Departments having been determined to have exceeded their useful purpose and are no longer necessary for any municipal purpose:
