ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT ODOT AIRPORT GRANT PROGRAM FY 2021 GRANT FUNDS FOR GRADING, MARKING AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS FOR TURF RUNWAYS AT THE MARION MUNICIPAL AIRPORT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The City of Marion has been given the opportunity to apply for Fiscal Year 2021 Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Airport Grant Program at the Marion Municipal Airport.

WHEREAS, The ODOT Fiscal Year 2021 Grant Program has awarded funds to the Marion Municipal Airport under this program at 100% project funding.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion, County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Service Director is hereby authorized to accept funding and enter into contract with ODOT for grant funds from the Fiscal Year 2021 Grant Program. Total Cost of this project is \$82,090 and ODOT has awarded this grant at 100% funded share.

Section 2. That the Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with Stevens Construction Company as winning bid contractor for this project.

Section 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept ODOT Grant Funds as awarded.

Section 4. The specifications of this project were prepared by GA Consultants of Sylvania, Ohio.

Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof, given the immediate need to make improvements and the deadlines involved in the grant process, and as such shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
