

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PUBLIC WORKS
DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH JACK DOHENY
COMPANIES, INC FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SEWER CAMERA, F-350 VAN,
AND VAN CONVERSION FOR THE CITY OF MARION OHIO, AND
APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has the understanding that the Water Pollution Control Department is desiring the purchase of a Sewer Camera, F-350 van, and van conversion; and

WHEREAS, Under ORC 9.48 (Joint Purchasing Programs), a political subdivision can participate in a joint purchasing program operated by or through a national or state association of political subdivision in which the purchasing political subdivision is eligible for membership; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Public Works Director is hereby authorized and is hereby directed to enter into contract with Jack Doheny Companies, Inc. for the purchase of a new Sewer Camera, F-350 van, and van conversion for use in the Water Pollution Control Department. The cost is \$105,703, which includes the trade in (\$33,500) of the 2006 International/Vactor Sewer Combination Unit with Asset Number 60573, and will be funded by the Sewer Revenue Fund Capital Equipment.

Section 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
