

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH BEST EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A (DEMO) THERMO-LAY ASPHALT PATCH TRUCK FOR THE STREETS DEPARTMENT AND WITH FREIGHTLINER FOR THE CHASSIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has the understanding that the Streets Department is in dire need of a new Thermo-lay Asphalt Patch Truck; and

WHEREAS, under ORC 9.48 (Joint purchasing programs), a political subdivision can participate in a joint purchasing program operated by or through a national or state association of political subdivision in which the purchasing political subdivision is eligible for membership; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Ohio: Marion County,

Section 1. That the PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR is hereby authorized and is hereby directed to enter into contract with BEST EQUIPMENT (Sourcewell pricing) for the purchase of a new Thermo-Lay Asphalt Patch Truck for use in the Streets Department. The Total cost is \$217,609. The cost includes Chassis from FREIGHTLINER and Asphalt Patch Box & Accessories from PB Loader are funded from the SCMR Fund 202.2006.5442.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
