

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR THE S. MAIN STREET SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT 21-1S, IN THE CITY OF MARION, OHIO, APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications, advertise for bids and enter into all necessary contracts for the S. Main Street Sewer Improvements, Project 21-1S.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable from the Storm and Sanitary Sewer Improvement Funds.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, welfare and safety of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof, and due to the imminent construction season and the need to move forward without further delay, and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
