

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH BURGESS & NIPLE, INC. FOR THE ENGINEERING AND DESIGN OF THE E. GEORGE STREET SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT 22-1S FOR THE CITY OF MARION, OHIO, APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2021-25 authorized the Service Director to conduct an RFP process for the E. George Street Sewer Improvement Project 22-1S for the City of Marion, Ohio and

**WHEREAS**, A Request for Proposal process was conducted with proposals due on January 21, 2022 and 3 firms responded. After a review of all proposals, Burgess & Niple, Inc. was selected and a design fee of \$105,000.00 was negotiated.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY** the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Works be directed to enter into contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. for the total amount of \$105,000.00 for the E. George Street Sewer Improvement Project 22-1S.

Section 2: That the cost of such contract shall be payable from the Sanitary Sewer and Storm Sewer Improvement Funds, and Auditor is authorized and directed to appropriate the necessary funds.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; and since E. George Street is in dire need of repair; and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council: otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
