ORDINANCE AMENDING EXISTING MARION CITY CODE SECTION 1360.99 RELATED TO DANGEROUS BUILDINGS FINDING A REAL AND PRESENT NEED TO ELIMINATE NUISANCES WITHIN THE CITY OF MARION, OHIO

Whereas the Council finds it necessary to modify the existing Code of the City of Marion related to controlling nuisance structures and holding responsible parties accountable within the City of Marion to be well taken, and

Whereas, the Council finds a real and present need to control certain un-wanted structures, failed or missing components and related nuisance items, which have been determined to be dangerous structures and/or nuisances within the City of Marion, Ohio

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARION, STATE OF OHIO

Section 1. CHAPTER 1360: DANGEROUS BUILDINGS:

§ 1360.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any provision of this chapter is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense which is punishable by a fine of not more than \$100. On a second offense within one year after the first offense, such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree which is punishable by not more than 30 days in jail and/or \$250. On each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense, such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree which is punishable by not more than 60 days in jail and/or \$500. ('70 Code, § 1360.99) (Ord. 68-86, passed 7-8-68; Am. Ord. 1989-122, passed 12-12-89)

SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ AS:

§ 1360.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any provision of this chapter is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense which is punishable by a fine of not more than \$150.00. On a second offense within Five years after the first offense, such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree which is punishable by not more than 30 days in jail and/or \$250. On a third offense within Five years after the second offense, such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree which is punishable by not more than 60 days in jail and/or \$500.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this Ordinance shall be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
