

**RESOLUTION RESTRICTING COVID-19 VACCINE STATUS AS A
CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT WITH THE CITY OF MARION**

Whereas, vaccines for COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) are available but have not received full granted approval by the US Food & Drug Administration

And Whereas, the United States Supreme Court has ruled the national vaccine mandate to be unconstitutional in nature.

Be it Resolved by the Council for the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. When accepting applications and hiring for open positions within the City of Marion, or for current City employees to maintain employment; The City of Marion shall not do either of the following:

- a. Require an individual to receive any vaccine that has not been granted full approval by the US Food & Drug Administration;
- b. Discriminate against any individual who has not received a vaccine described in section (1)(a) of this section, including requiring the individual to engage in, or refrain from engaging in activities or precautions that differ from the activities or precautions of an individual who has received such vaccine as described in section (1)(a) of this section.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
