

ORDINANCE AMENDING MARION CITY CODE SECTION 194.07 (B)(1)
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Council for the City of Marion finds it necessary to amend existing Marion City Code section 718.08,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Marion to amend Marion City Code section 194.07 (B)(1) as follows:

194.07 DECLARATION OF ESTIMATED TAX

...

(B) (1) Every taxpayer shall make a declaration of estimated taxes for the current taxable year, on the form prescribed by the Tax Administrator, if the amount payable as estimated taxes is at least **one thousand** dollars. For the purposes of this section:

...

Section 2. This amendment shall be effective January 1, 2022. Any provision, section or subsection not amended herein shall remain in full force as previously adopted.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and its' inhabitants thereof; given the immediate need to revise the provision in advance of the next tax season for the benefit of the health, welfare, regulation and local enforcement/police power of the residents of the City of Marion, Ohio; and as such shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its' passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all member elected to Council, otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
