• Letter from OAG's Office regarding COVID19 Vaccine

Chief McDonald explained that this asking DeWine to make this designation within the tier 1B schedule as they have done in other states. They are asking Council to join the call from FOP, OAG, and Chiefs of Police Association. Officers are at great risk of contracting COVID-19 through their employment. They are not asking to replace anyone currently listed, just to be placed in beside the other identified populations for the tier. We are currently in phase 1B of scheduling.

Chief explained that EMS has already had opportunity to get vaccinated. Law Enforcement were supposed to be in 1B but were pushed back by the State (not local Public Health). They do not know when they are scheduled. They have had some officers get the vaccinations due to cancelations.
