Item 1. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATED MUNICIPAL COURT VETERANS GRANT FUND MONIES TO THE MUNICIPAL COURT ASSISTANCE FUND TO COVER TRAVEL EXPENSES FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021. (Stotts)

Item 2. ORDINANCE MAKING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FUNDS AS PROVIDED FOR BELOW FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021. (Watts)

Auditor Watts explained that departments are underfunded and these appropriations will take them through the end of the year. Additional funds are for three police cruisers through the end of the year. They are a lease-to-buy. These are the last leases that they have. Other cruisers are being purchased.

Auditor Watts stated that he and Tom Pannett (Treasurer) have worked with Fahey Bank. Currently, Pannett is the sole signer on the account. Funds are secure and safe.

The bank was getting mixed signals about who had authority due to changes in status and disputes in staffing in the Auditor's Office. This eased the bank's mind about who is in charge. Once a new Auditor is appointed, they will be signer on the account.

Mayor Schertzer said that ORC specifies that the Treasurer must be on the accounts. It has been a tradition that the Auditor is on the account as well. This action makes the account more secure with less people able to take action.
