Whereas the _____ herein after referred to as the "Organization" and the City of Marion, herein after referred to as the "City" have agreed that the Organization will be a participant in the City's Adopt-An-Island program with the Organization agreeing it shall abide by the rules and directives as promulgated by the City, specifically that said use will be consistent with all conditions imposed by City and further that the Organization assumes all risk for injury which may occur during the activity and use of the facilities and shall hold the City, its' Officers, employees and agents harmless for all injuries which may occur as a result of the Organization and any member thereof. The Organization and all members waive all claims present and future against the City, its' Officers, employees and agents for injuries or damages which arise from participation in anyway. Further, Organization expressly agrees that any release and/or waivers it possesses on behalf of its participants shall extend to City as if same was executed for the City and the Organization shall be primarily liable to its participants for any and all injuries which may arise from participation. The undersigned has read the above agreement fully and after doing so executes same of his/her own free will in exchange for the ability to participate.

Other Notations

- A. The applicant agrees to consult with Marion City Parks Department on the type/style of planting(s) and to submit a general landscaping plan to the Office of the Service Director. No planting will exceed 24" in height at full mature growth.
- B. In the sole judgment of the city, the city of Marion reserves the right to trim/shape any plantings on the island in order to maintain vehicular and pedestrian safety and, further, to intervene if the island is not maintained up to acceptable standards of care.
- C. The applicant agrees to abide by the City's signage size/design criteria.
- D. The city makes no commitments relative to recognizing this application beyond December 31, 2011 at which time it may be renewed or revoked.
