Marion Senior Center Member Guidelines

The Marion Senior Center strives to provide a safe, clean, and friendly environment for all our members, and to treat all members with fairness and respect. We ask that members behave respectfully toward each other and the staff. Non-members aged 50 or older are permitted to visit as a guest two times per year.

Individuals must be age 50 or older to become a member of the Marion Senior Center. A current membership card is required to enter the center, and to participate in programs and activities. Members must log in.

For the comfort and safety of our members:

- Appropriate clothing and shoes are required at the Senior Center.
- Alcoholic beverages and/or smoking are not allowed in the Senior Center.
- Resources and limited number of personal hygiene products are available in restrooms.
- Members and/or guests who appear to have any flu-like symptoms upon arrival or become sick during the day will be asked to leave to protect the health and safety of others in the facility.

The following behaviors will result in temporary or indefinite suspension of membership:

*Menacing or threatening behavior	*Acting out in anger
*Physical assault	*Repeated intoxication
*Abuse or destruction of center property	*Rude behavior, including abusive language

Waiver of Liability:

The City of Marion does not assume liability for any injury or death, or loss of personal property to members or guests suffered or incurred at the premises, including but not limited to the premises, sidewalks, walkways, drives, parking lots, or the structures on the premises for the following circumstances:

- A loss of property by theft or burglary
- Accidental damage to person or property from the use of premises
- Damage or injury caused by action of the natural elements
- Damage or injury resulting from the conduct of employees or other members whether negligent or otherwise
